Where His feet pass.

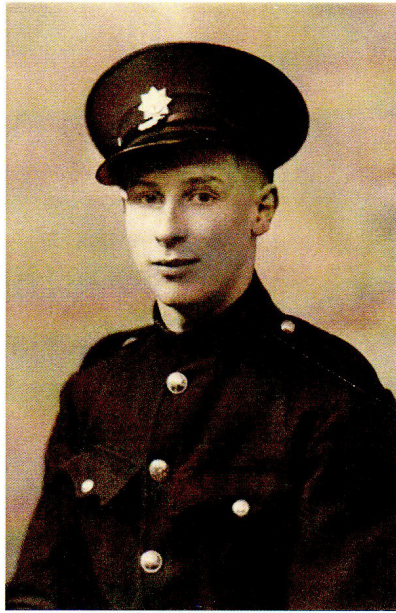
Mine is the sunlight
