### The Friends of St James the Great, Thorley



The Friends of St James the Great, Thorley was founded in 1983 to assist the Rector and Parochial Church Council in maintaining and beautifying the Church and Churchyard.

We seek to raise funds by organising events, such as the Festival of Flowers and Music which is held every year over the August Bank Holiday Weekend, and through

membership subscriptions.

Our most recent fund-raising campaign was to replace the Church organ. This was affectionately known as 'the mongrel' because it had been brought together over a number of years from a variety of different sources. Its chequered history meant that there were serious shortcomings in both its functionality and its ability to cope with the tonal and dynamic variation so much associated with even a relatively 'basic' organ. Following our campaign, 'the mongrel' was finally removed and, on 6 May 2010, replaced by a 37 Stop Two Manual Allan electronic organ. Its purchase brought the total sum contributed by the Friends since 2000 in support of our remit to  $\pounds100,000$ .

We have produced a DVD showing photographs of this year's flower arrangements accompanied by music played on the new organ by Simon Dellow, Director of Music at St James. This is available from the Friends' souvenir stall in the St Barnabas Centre.

This year's Festival has as its objective raising money to enable restoration work to be undertaken on a number of the Church windows and the stained glass that they contain.




## In the Church

Times for individual items are displayed throughout the site.


