


THE 2013 FESTIVAL OF FLOWERS & MUSIC



The theme of this year's Festival is The Celebration of Marriage

The Festival is organised by the Friends of St James the Great, Thorley. Established in 1983, thirty years ago this year, the Friends raises funds to assist the Parochial Church Council in maintaining and beautifying the Church and Churchyard.

The first major project undertaken with funding from the Friends was the construction of a new north wall for the Churchyard in 1986. The August Bank

Holiday weekend of 1987 saw the Friends launch a major restoration Appeal. The Church was decorated with flowers for this occasion, and by popular demand it became the first in an annual series of Festivals of Flowers and Music.

Since its formation, the Friends of St James has raised over £180,000 which has enabled numerous projects to be undertaken. Most recently we funded the purchase of a new Church Organ, and the restoration of Church stonework and a number of stained glass windows and repairs to the churchyard wall.

This year's Festival has as its objective raising money in support of our latest project, the purchase and installation of new Church lighting and further restoration work on the fabric of the Church.






